Rütgers Chemicals (RC) belongs to the world leaders regarding the production of tar products. RC produces aromatic hydrocarbons, aromatic heterocompounds, aromatic oils, resins, hydrocarbon products and bonding agents mainly from anthracite tar of German or foreign coking plants and from petrochemical by-products such as high-boiling oil fractions.

Some of the sites have been used for industrial purposes since the 1890s, starting out with a wood impregnation plant and a tar distillery. All activities since were tar related. Selected sites were heavily bombarded in WWII.
